#### Course Title: Laser Activated Irrigation: Does it Work?

#### Learning Objectives

#### **Course Synopsis:**

The New Jersey Endodontic Association Annual Winter Symposium introduced the concept of minimally invasive endodontics 13 years ago. It is now well accepted that conservation of tooth structure during endodontic therapy is paramount in retaining the structural integrity of endodontically treated teeth. As we have accepted the challenge to reduce the endodontic access cavity and canal shapes, the question of adequate canal debridement and disinfection has become a significant consideration. The inadequacies of canal disinfection from traditional needle irrigation are well known. This webinar will address how incorporation of the laser accomplishes our goals for canal debridement and canal disinfection through minimally invasive endodontic access preparations and canal shapes. The ergonomic flow and multifunctional capabilities(endo, perio, implants, soft tissue, hard tissue) of the laser make this an ideal technology for the endodontist.

Dr. Maupin and 1 or more endodontic colleagues will provide a live 30-minute Q & A session at the end of his recorded presentations. The first 45 minutes will be entirely didactic in nature. The second 45-minute presentation will be a recorded and appropriately edited video of the treatment of a patient in Dr. Maupin's office employing the Biolase laser during the endodontic procedure. Each of the 2 45-minute sessions will have 5-minute breaks to allow our participants to refresh themselves.
